## 2011 MW&W RR Annual Report


The 2011 operating season began in March with snow still on the ground and continued into early December.

The year saw many improvements in both the physical plant and rolling stock. These include:

New depots with lights at Willoughby & Avegadro Falls, new Willoughby water tank, old tank moved to Avegadro Falls; new track 3 at Willoughby; new bridges: Avegadro Falls, Avegadro Creek east approach with support towers, West Willoughby truss; new trestle at Kermit; new signage at Mt. Duckmore and Kermit.













